

Breezy Point City Council
January 25, 2021 - 7:00 pm
City Council Workshop Meeting Minutes

The meeting of the Breezy Point City Council was called to order by Mayor Todd Roggenkamp at 7:00 p.m. Councilmembers present were Gary Bakken, Rebecca Ball, Mark Miller, and Michael Moroni. City Administrator/Clerk Wussow was also in attendance. All present stood for the pledge of allegiance.

Mayor Roggenkamp reviewed that the meeting was a goal setting session for the new City Council. Each City Council member had identified several goals that they would like addressed in the next couple of years.

Every City Council member was given the opportunity to present the goals that they had submitted and were included in the City Council packet. The City Council then reviewed and commented on the goals presented and came to the following results in no particular order:

Short Term Goals

1. Create Feasibility report for a Community Center
2. Replace City Hall Playground equipment or expand Disc golf course
3. Create Economic Development stimulus plan
4. Rebuild Buschmann Road with Cooperative group or as a stand-alone project
5. Develop Police Department succession plan
6. Hire Full-time Planner, or Building Official, or Combination
7. Ongoing - Enforce planning and zoning, golf cart, and parking laws
8. Review alternatives for expanding grant writing/applications

Long Term Goals

1. Recreational Trails Including
 - a. Walking
 - b. Golf carts
 - c. Biking
 - d. ATV's
2. Review all City Ordinances. Not just Vacation rentals.
3. Replace City Hall Playground equipment or Expansion of Disc golf course
4. Explore option to improve internet service in the City of Breezy Point
5. Continue to review alternatives to improve minimum maintenance Roads

The City Council agreed that most if not all goals would be considered ongoing as many need to complete first steps to continue on to phase two and some with phase three. Additionally, the City Council agreed that many or most of the goals should be finalized with the related Committee. For example, the Park and Recreation Committee should recommend if the playground equipment be replaced

or the expansion of disc golf course happen in 2021; decide which of the two projects should happen in 2022.

Staff was instructed to create a formal 2021-2022 Goals document and present at an upcoming City Council meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:14 p.m.
